

IASSID – possible rules changes to be brought to the committee.

Article III.

Under Powers – second paragraph “no substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office”.

Query: Does this need to be looked at in the context of public statements which could be aimed at having a negative impact on people with disabilities?

Article IV.

Members – Research centres need to be included.

Article VI.

Query whether the company’s office should be notified of changes e.g. composition of board, rule changes, size of membership after each General Assembly?

Article III.

Composition of Assembly – need to change (b) organisational size to fit current invoicing policy.

Should (e) be changed, changing Secretary to Vice President constitutional affairs – or should this continue to be a function of the Secretary?

Article VI.

Section 3 – change needs to be made to reflect change – agreed in Seattle.
